

ROOFING CONTRACTORS ASSOCIATION OF CALIFORNIA 2022 HARRY MULLIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Membership in RCAC is required in order to participate in our Scholarship Program.

The Roofing Contractors Association of California will grant scholarships up to \$2,000.00 to the immediate family of members and their employees in memory of the late Harry Mullin. (*Immediate family is defined as self, spouse, child, grandchild, or stepchild.*) For the purpose of this scholarship, eligibility is limited to the employees and immediate family of the RCAC Contractor, Associate and Sponsor members in good standing. (*Families of current Board members are ineligible.*) We look forward to helping as many deserving applicants as possible. The availability of scholarship funds is highly predicated upon the success of our annual events. We ask that your company continue to support us in this great cause.

Objective

To enable qualified professionals through education.

Eligibility

All candidates must currently be:

- 1. High school seniors, undergraduate or graduate students at an accredited community college, state college, or university.
- 2. Provisionally accepted as students into undergraduate or graduate degree programs for the coming academic year by accredited colleges, universities, or trade schools.

Entry Requirements

The following data is required from each candidate:

- 1. A COMPLETED official Application Form. NEATNESS IS A CONSIDERATION.
- 2. A letter from the college, university, or trade school where the graduate or undergraduate work will be undertaken, indicating provisional acceptance of the proposed course of study.
- 3. An official transcript of all high school and college records.

Awards

- 1. Multiple scholarships are typically awarded. Scholarships range from \$500.00 to \$2,000.00 per student.
- 2. Although the intent of the Harry Mullin Memorial Scholarship is to recognize outstanding nominees, should candidates rank equally in the judgment of the Scholarship Committee, the level of need shall be considered the final criteria.
- 3. One half of the scholarship award will be sent to the Office of the Bursar of the institution where the recipient will do his/her academic work, and one half will be sent to the recipient.
- 4. For the purposes of allocation, the funds of this scholarship are to be used with the following priorities: tuition and fees, book purchases, room and board, and other expenses.
- 5. All scholarship awards will be formally announced at an official function of the Roofing Contractors Association of California.

DEADLINE: All completed entries must be postmarked no later than Friday, July 22, 2022.

Judging

- 1. The Scholarship Committee has the sole authority for granting the awards. The scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic performance, faculty recommendations, extracurricular activities, employment experience, and financial need.
- 2. All applicants selected as finalists may be subject to personal interview with representatives of the Scholarship Committee.
- 3. Scholarships will be awarded without consideration of race, creed, national origin, sexual orientation, or gender.
- 4. Because the scholarship program was funded with monies from the Associated Roofing Contractors of Northern California (ARCNC), in the event of a tie between applicants, a bonus point will be awarded to applicants who are residents of the ARCNC territory to break the tie.
